BEKI Building Fund: An Urgent Appeal

At our recent congregational meeting held on Tuesday, January 3rd, it was voted and passed by the congregation that we would go ahead with repairs to our building's roof and exterior masonry. These repairs are scheduled to begin in April. Since BEKI has no existing building fund, we must make this appeal directly. We urgently need your help to meet the cost of these repairs as soon as possible so that the work can begin as scheduled.

As we all know, extensive roof repairs have been needed for (at least) the past four years. The severity of the past winters has increased the damage. Unfortunately, we have had to "make do" with patches. While these attempts have temporarily staved off the inevitable, they have been very costly and have not resolved the underlying problems. In addition, every roof leak causes damage to the interior ceilings and walls. Repairing this damage is especially expensive in the main sanctuary because it involves the use of scaffolding and special equipment. The longer we put off repairing the roof and exterior masonry, the greater the interior damage will be.

The Building and Maintenance Committee has requested bids from a number of contractors to do the following: put on a new roof over all four sections of the building with a 25-year warantee, replace damaged bricks (glazed bricks that must be ordered specially), recaulk the window frames, power wash the entire building to remove all stains and mold, and completely

waterproof all the brickwork in the building. The lowest bids combined to equal \$110,000, if we begin the process now. Waiting would raise the bids by at least \$5,000. We must be prepared to pay for the project by the end of January.

A Message From Rabbi Tilsen

My First Cousin

I am the youngest of my paternal grandparents' twenty-two grandchildren and almost the youngest of my maternal grandparents' fifteen grandchildren. All of us grew up in the Twin Cities Metropolitan area in Minnesota. No seder table was too long, no home was too large, no park was too spacious for our family gatherings. A week did not go by without seeing my cousins.

My cousin Nicholas Chaim Tilsen was born in 1951. He was more than ten years older than me, and I did not know him as well as did my siblings who were his contemporaries and his classmates in high school.

Nick was a talented chef, and when he lived in the San Francisco Bay Area he had a catering business. Nick was fit and energetic and had developed an extensive network of friends who cared deeply about him and about each other. He was an essential part of his community and of his family.

Nick was my first cousin to die. He died of AIDS in 1990, among the first few thousand to succumb to this retrovirus. He died in the loving care of his family and friends. His death left us diminished and we are still grieving to this day.

As we approach his fifth yahrzeit I observe that the level of pain and death brought by the disease seems incomprehensible. Millions of people are infected with a virus with a 100% mortality rate and no cure in sight. The agonizing medical effects of the virus are compounded by the social and legal stigma of the HIV-positive label. The devastation touches us all.

My first cousin performed many deeds of kindness during his life and enriched the lives of his family and friends. May his memory be a blessing.

Dear Rabbi,

At weekday evening services you read two different lists of yahrzeit names. What's going on? I don't get it.

Dear Reader,

The first list is the names of those whose yahrzeit occurs on the day that is coming to an end (the date on the Hebrew Calendar changes at sundown). This first list goes along with the Minha afternoon service. The second list is the names of those whose yahrzeit occurs on the new day that is beginning at sunset. This second list goes along with the evening service.

Dear Rabbi,

I have noticed that the candle lighting times are different in the BEKI Bulletin, the Ledger, and on my Jewish calendar. Why are they different? Which one is right?

Signed, Four Minutes Off Dear Four Minutes,

The candle lighting times published in the BEKI Bulletin are calculated for the exact polar coordinates of Beth El-Keser Israel. Some other sources use a point in the region a few miles away, which accounts for a minute's difference.

Some sources simply guess by splitting the difference between New York and Hartford sunset times. Some sources rely on the civil definition of sunset (i.e. when one-half of the solar sphere appears to be below the horizon) instead of the halakhic definition (i.e. when the entire sphere is below the horizon), accounting for the difference of another minute or two.

Your most accurate source for New Haven candle-lighting times is the BEKI Bulletin.
