My mother was born in the Bronx on January 20, 1931, to her loving parents Samuel and Anne Miller. She and her older brother Melvin (known as “The Little Professor” because he was a scientist even as a child) were best friends throughout their lives.

Sam and Anne ran the Park Plaza pharmacy in the Bronx where their kids would go after school to do their homework and help out.

Mom was a talented pianist, and her love of music was a constant throughout her life. She attended Queens College where she majored in music and education and played on the women’s basketball team. At 5’1” Mom might have been one of the taller players!

Music was her passion, and she was lucky enough to be able to make a successful career teaching choir and piano in New York public schools for thirty-five years. There are many amusing stories from her decades at Walton High School in the Bronx. Even after retirement Mom continued singing in her synagogue in Peekskill, New York, and with the choir at The Towers.

Mom’s marriage to my dad, Joshua Sokolow, did not last long, but even with a full-time career, outside interests, and many extended family responsibilities, Mom continued to be a devoted and loving mother her entire life. At my bar mitzvah the rabbi introduced Mom to Theodore (“Ted”) Landsberg, a widower. They were married the following year and enjoyed a wonderful marriage until it ended too soon with Ted’s death in 1994. Through her marriage to Ted, Mom became a loving mother to Mady Landsberg, Ted’s daughter. She always referred to Mady as her daughter, never her step-daughter, and Mady’s son, Perry, as her grandchild.

Mom loved being in synagogue for all kinds of activities. She and Ted were licensed bingo callers for the Hebrew Institute of Riverdale. Later, she served on the board of Congregation Sons of Israel and was a regular at services in The Towers.

She was frequently in New Haven to visit Ina and me, and her grandchildren Shai and Avital. BEKI congregants remember her from her frequent visits to our shul where she developed many close friendships. As a youngster Tova Benson Tilsen began calling her “Grandma Martian” many years ago which was a favorite family moniker.

For nearly forty years Mom was a close friend of Ina’s Mom, Lillian Silverman. They traveled together often, going to senior camps, on cruises, and to Israel. They enjoyed playing duets on the piano.

Eventually they both moved to The Towers in New Haven with Ina's aunt Harriet Suslew. They were known as "The Three Musketeers" and had a very special relationship they each cherished.

Mom had moved to The Towers about ten years ago to be able to age in place closer to family. She immediately became active in the shul there, the choir, the Yiddish club, and loved just hanging out and schmoozing. One of the highlights of her life was when she and Lillian became adult b'nai mitzvah at the Towers in 2017 after a year of study with Rabbi Ben Scolnic.

Mom was always smiling and happy to talk with anyone. Her greatest joy came from her grandchildren Shai, Avital, and Perry, and her great-grandchildren Maya, Sophie, and Ellie.

Despite being traumatized by a dog as a child, she even learned to love all of Jay and Ina's dogs over the years.

Mom died at ninety-four years of age having suffered with progressing dementia for several years. It was very difficult to watch her be robbed of the ability to communicate and live independently but I hope she understood that she was always surrounded by the love of her family and her special angel, her aide Hyacinth Vernon. May she enjoy eternal rest in peace under the wings of the Shekhinah.
