The Mishna, compiled by Rabbi Yehuda HaNasi in the second century of the common era, represents an essential source of rabbinic law and wisdom. Tractate Berakhot deals with the timing of daily prayers, rules for recitation of the Shema and Amida, and other common rituals. Study of Berakhot sheds light on ancient and modern life and provides insight into the sources for our current practices.
